1. Teachers and Coaches To broaden the base of teachers and coaches for the sport of diving	Increase the number of qualified coaches in the County. Review the need for courses and direct as necessary.	Candidates from both BDA and DDC continue to support organised courses within the county where available. 3 coaches from DDC attended a Level 1 Diving Coaches course in January 2012. DDC and BDA have approx 2 candidates each for the next available Level 2 course, but there is concern over funding. Ongoing, try to increase dissemination of information within clubs as appropriate
2. Facilities 2.1 To establish and maintain an audit of all Diving facilities within the County, their availability and cost. 2.2 To maintain and develop existing diving facilities.	Update database, already established in 2006, and liaise with ASA East Region. Review and promote the development of facilities at existing centres.	Ongoing, diving manager to complete and update DDC have installed a second set of wall bars for their dryland training room. BDA have installed a second TIVO system, to allow one on each side of the pool.
3. Performance and Excellence To establish and fund an improvement plan for teachers, coaches and divers within the County.	Organise Coaches and Divers Seminars, to be given by Diving specialists. Organise dry land training for divers to support their continual development.	DB will review the options for suitable Specialists for a Seminar and has a list of potential speakers. DDC also looking into this. Ongoing. BDA has one dry land session per week for selected divers, looking to increase where available. DDC have 3 sessions of dryland per week

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4. Support structures 4.1 To provide the necessary training, thus establishing an infrastructure of judges, recorders and administrators 4.2 To encourage County Clubs to produce their own Development Plans and become Swim 21 accredited.	Review the Officials List and organise courses as necessary. All clubs to be Swim 21 qualified and have an on-going development plan by December 2011.	More courses will be organised as required and where possible, there is still the requirement for a course that covers both manual recording and dive recorder. BDA has completed and submitted Swim 21 application, and have been accepted at the teaching level of Swim 21. DDC continue to pursue accreditation in near future.
5. Competition Programme To review the County competition programme, amending where necessary, to ensure that the County structure will complement the ASAER and National programmes.	Alter the event programme and requirements where necessary Participate in Partnership events with other Regions.	County competition programme currently undergoing review, current conditions to remain the same for novice and 1m/3m and 5m events, with age group event conditions to be discussed further. County divers are competing in all the current Partnership events as appropriate
