The storage unit is - Access Safe Storage, Gunnels Wood Rd, Stevenage SG1 2GR

The AOE pad trolley with the pads on it is 200cm long; 130cm high and 80cm deep, and it has a padded cover over them.

The scoreboard is 140 long; 190cm high and 75cm deep and again it has a padded cover.

Both have zips for ease of use.

It is essential that the covers are over the kit when being transported and when stored. Of course everything must be dry when being stored. There is a towel in the kit to facilitate that, but that needs to be washed and dried before it is stored as well.

The measurements are there so that you have an idea of the size of vehicle required to transport the kit safely. It is all very heavy and ideally a team of four is required to move everything, two can do it but be careful.
